## Air API-connected carriers



Universal API's single access point provides Air API-connected carriers, including low cost carrier (LCC) data, in a standardized, end-to-end workflow that enables you to maintain one API connection with multiple carriers. In addition, Travelport maintains the connection so you can take advantage of new functionality offered by each carrier without the need for additional coding.

Each Air API-connected carrier is unique, leading to variation among specific carrier implementations. Travelport standardizes functionality as much as possible, but there can be exceptions based on the capabilities of each individual carrier. Travelport's developer portal (<a href="www.developer.travelport.com">www.developer.travelport.com</a>) enables you to quickly access new carrier content for your application.




